New market access issues

USA – export of South Africa's maize seed



We are happy to report that the South African Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (DAFF) has confirmed that on the 29 July 2015, the outstanding Maize seed supporting information was communicated to the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS). This information will now be used to finalise the Pest Risk Analysis (PRA).

Thereafter a draft PRA will be communicated to DAFF for inputs, comments and proposals on mitigation measures with regard to the US identified quarantine pests.

Pest Alert

Maize Lethal Necrosis Disease (MLND)

On 21 August 2015, a WTO-SPS notification (G/SPS/N/ZAF/39) from South Africa was issued to all trading partners, notifying the Emergency Phytosanitary measures to prevent the introduction and spread within South Africa of MLND, on the importation of Maize seed and grain.

SANSOR provided a combined industry document to DAFF on 15 October 2015, highlighting the concerns raised by the industry with regard to the technical justification of the emergency measures proposed.

A new draft to be released in May 2016 by the International Plant Protection Convention's (IPPC) Standard Committee for a second country consultation.

Announcements

- The 2015 theoretical evaluation for phytosanitary authorisation for SANSOR inspectors took place on 7 September 2015 at SANSOR's office by the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (DAFF).
- All 9 inspectors registered for the examination passed
- 7 SANSOR inspectors have been authorised to conduct phytosanitary field inspection on behalf of DAFF in 2015.

SANSOR and DAFF is in the process to update the course material.
