



Restitution

Property clause: Section 25(7) of the Bill of Rights says:

"A person or community dispossessed of property after 19 June 1913 as a result of past racially discriminatory laws or practices is entitled, to the extent provided by an Act of Parliament, either to restitution of that property or to equitable redress."

Land restitution: 1995 - 2013



Nearly 30,000 claims not yet finalised (2013)

Redistribution

Property clause: Section 25(5) of the Bill of Rights says:

"The state must take reasonable legislative and other measures, within its available resources, to foster conditions which enable citizens to gain access to land on an equitable basis."

Three cycles of land redistribution

- 1994-1999: the SLAG years
 - R16,000 household grants
 - Large group, whole-farm projects
 - Priority on settlement and multiple livelihoods
- 2000-2006: the LRAD years
 - R20-100,000 individual grants
 - Small group, whole-farm projects
 - Priority on commercial farming, but also 'safety net'
- 2006 to the present: the PLAS / SLLDP years
 - State purchase of land (exclusively from 2011)
 - Allocation on leasehold with option to purchase (then not)
 - Priority unclear; same as (as broad as) LRAD?

Tenure reform

Property clause: Section 25(6) of the Bill of Rights says:

"A person or community whose tenure of land is legally insecure as a result of past racially discriminatory laws or practices is entitled, to the extent provided by an Act of Parliament, either to tenure which is legally secure or to comparable redress."


