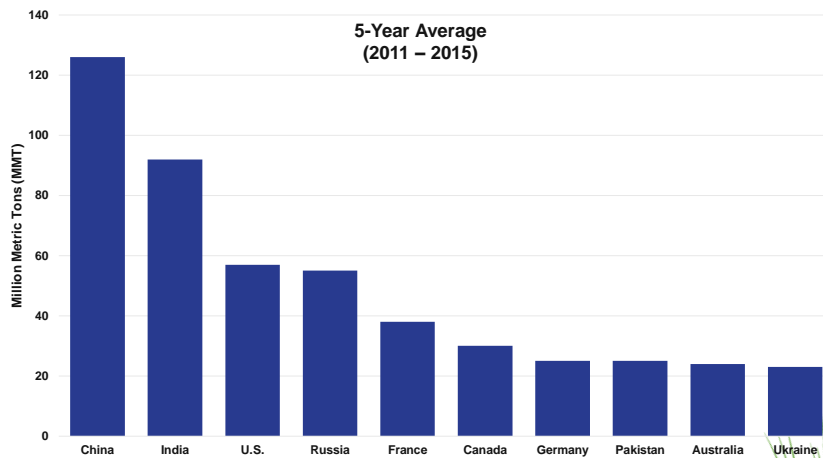

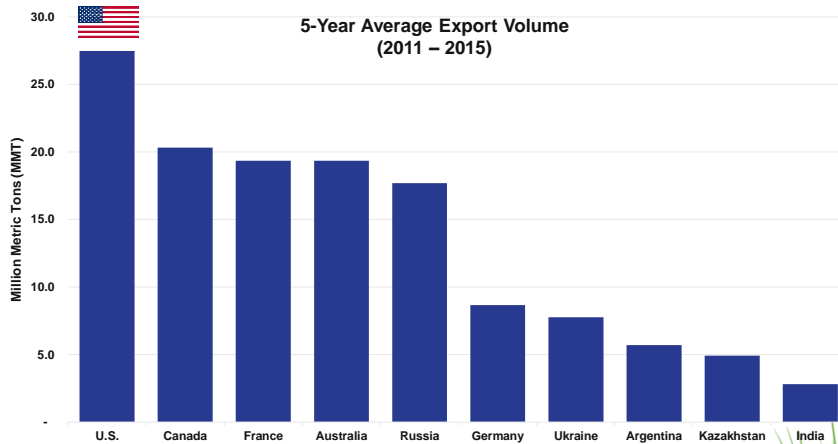


World Wheat Production Leaders

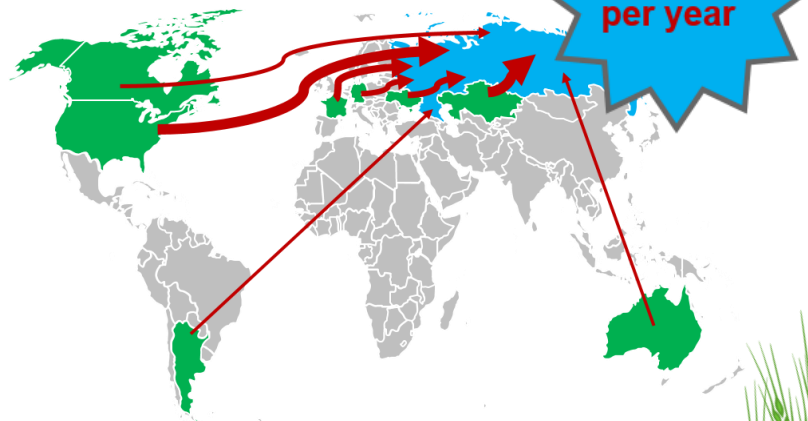

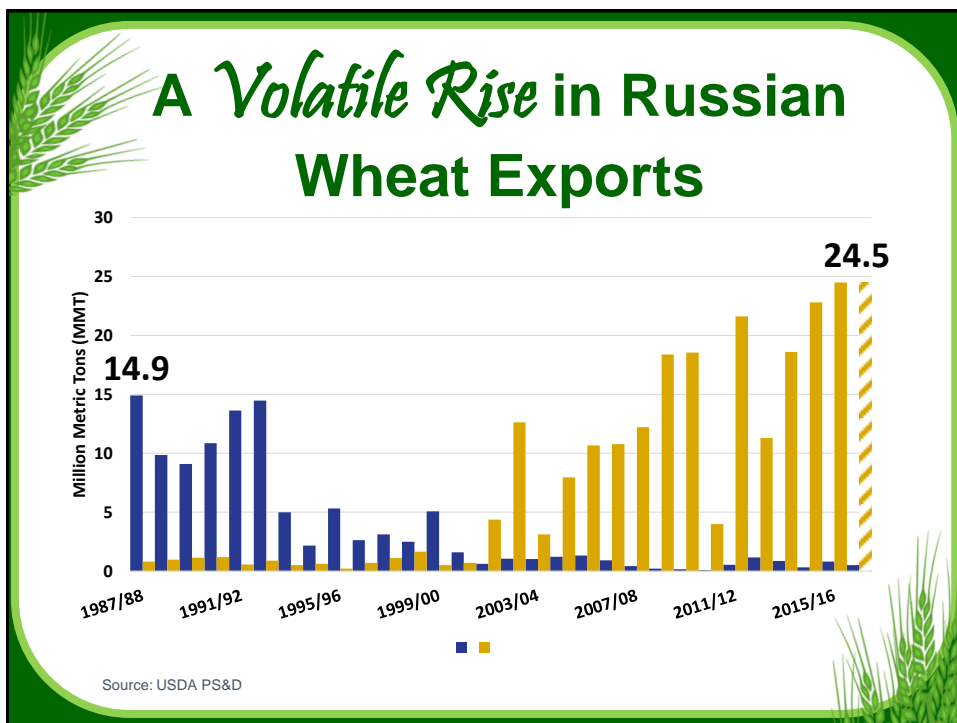
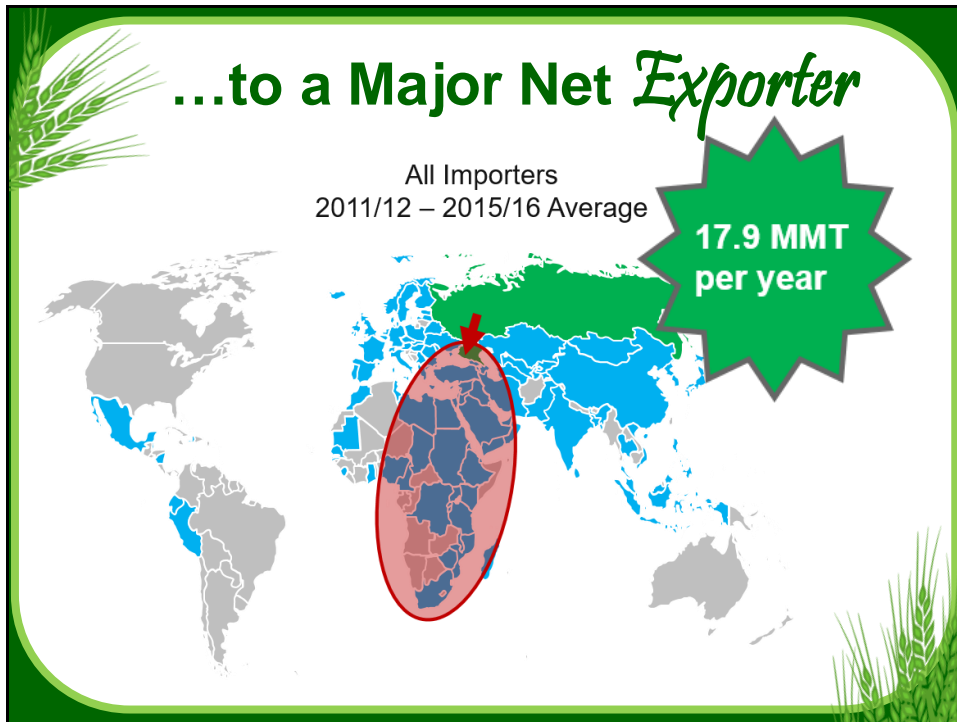


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Russia Changed from a Net *Importer*...

1996-2001 Average



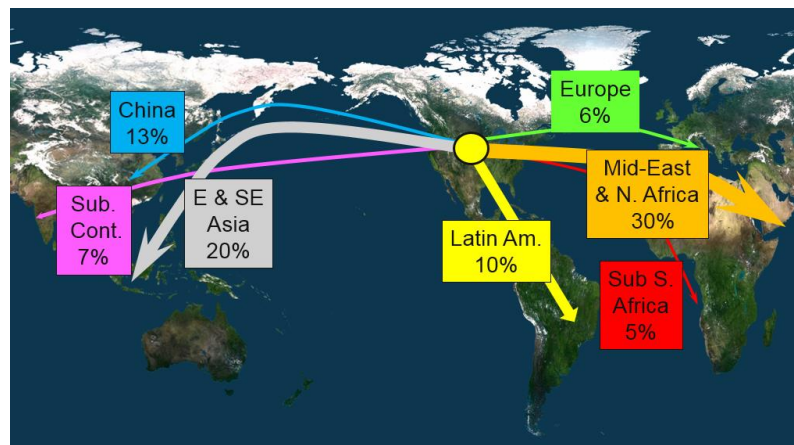


Russia's Rise *Impacts* U.S. Wheat Export *Direction*

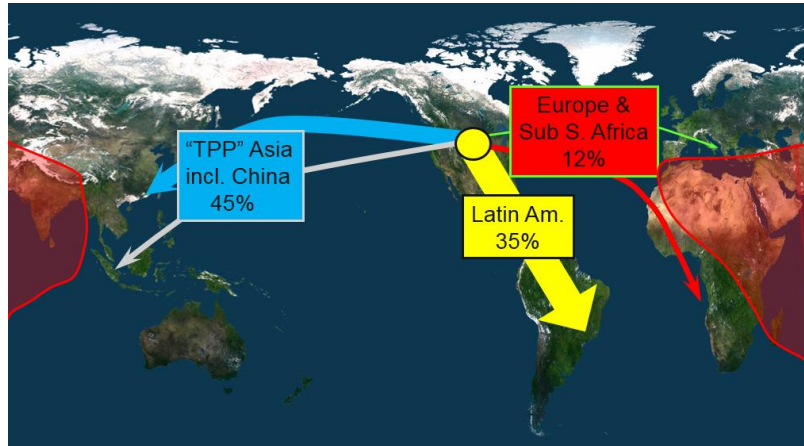

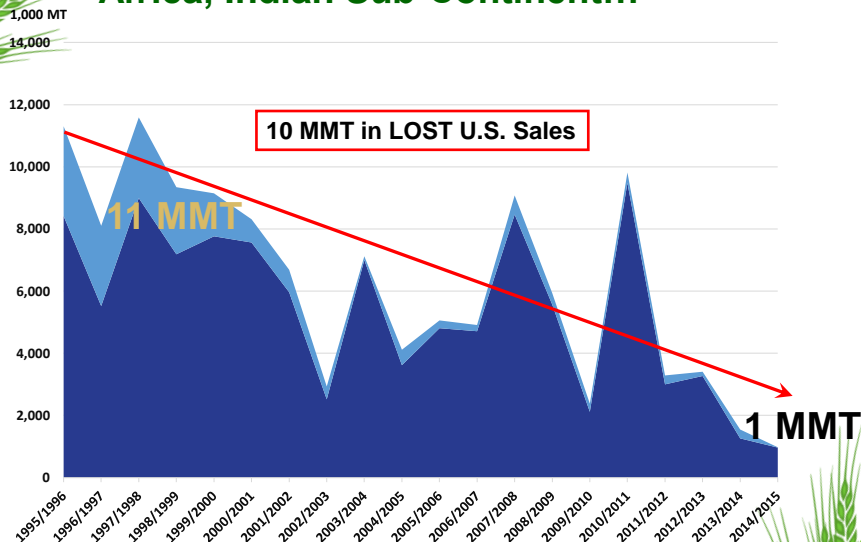
U.S. Wheat Trade Flow 1985 – 1990

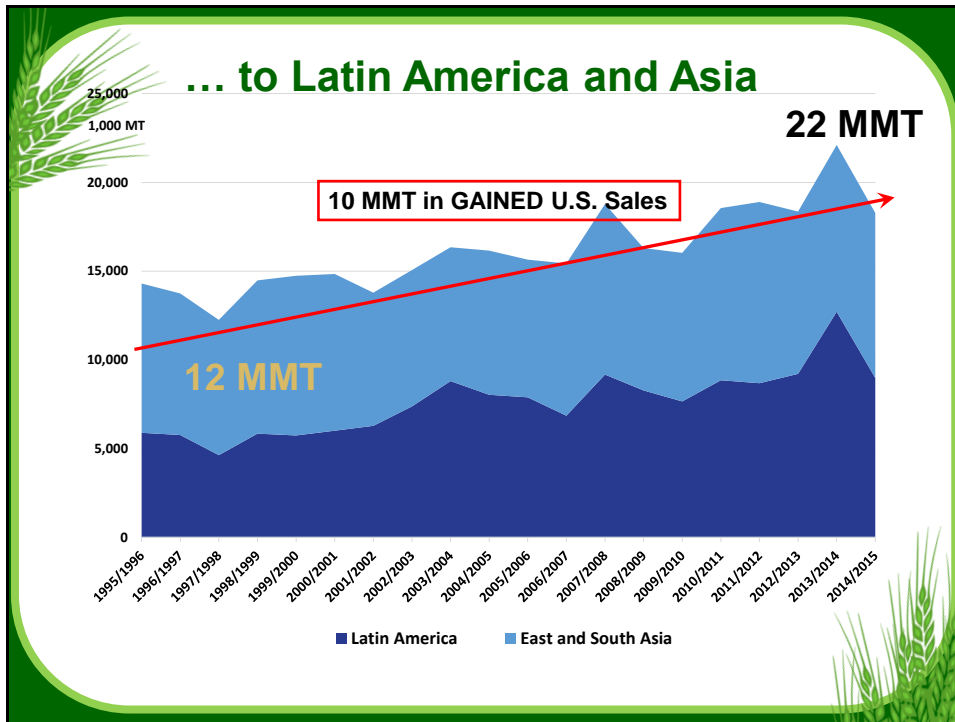


U.S. Wheat Trade Flow 2011-2015

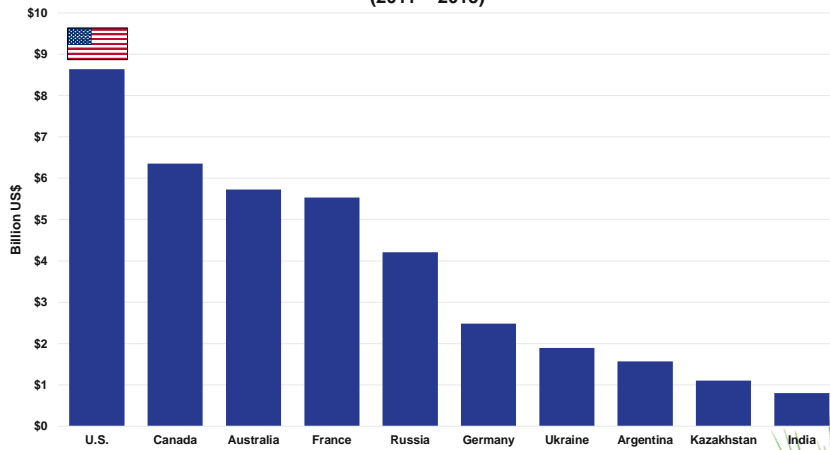

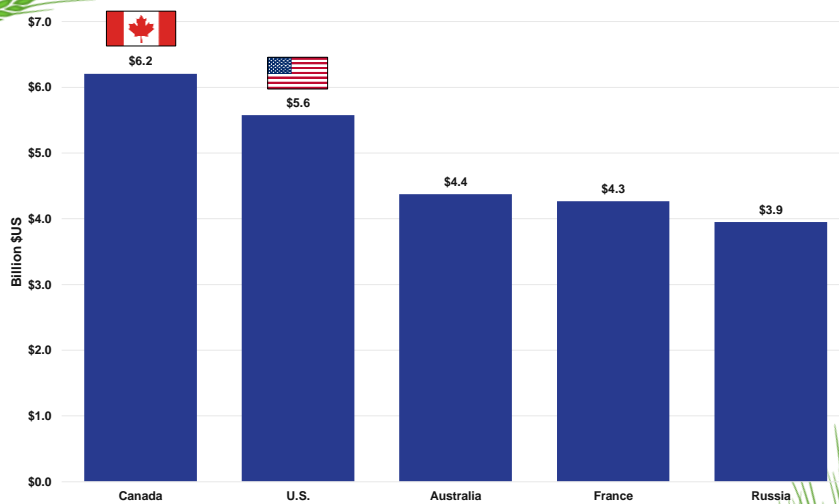
Wheat Export Value Leaders

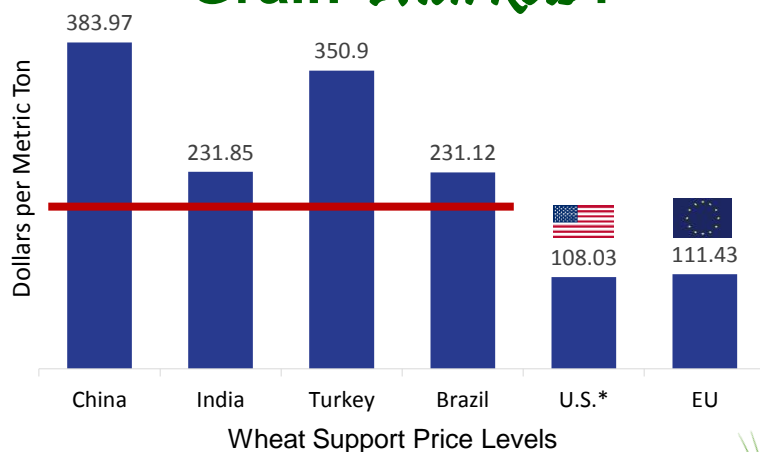
Canadian Volume Pushed 2016 Total Value

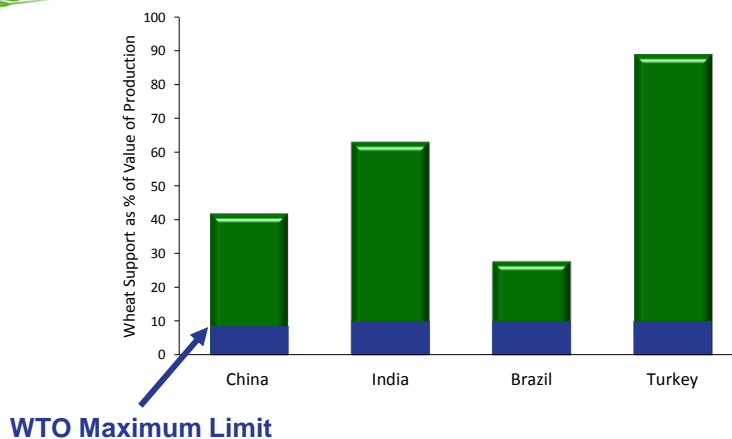

Impact on U.S. Wheat Production, Cash Price and Revenue

If Price and Input Subsidies Eliminated In:	Change in Total U.S. Farm Revenue from wheat
China	+ \$653 million
India	+ \$358 million
Turkey	+ \$172 million
Brazil	+ \$23 million
All Four	+ \$1 billion approx.

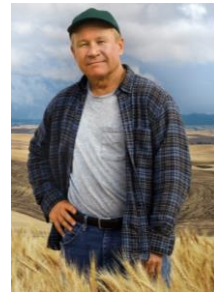

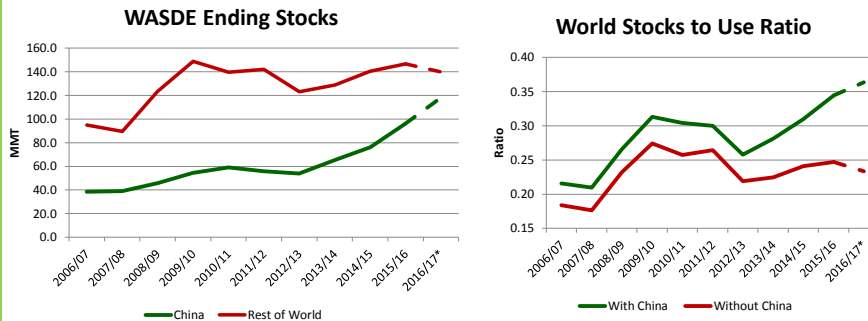
China Support Policies Hurt All Wheat Exporters

- U.S. wheat demand shifted to Asia and Latin America

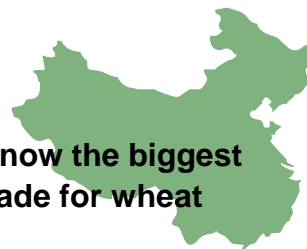
