Reporting to the COO, the Logistics Manager will be responsible to trouble shoot and provide operational solutions for logistic challenges.

**Duties and responsibilities**

- Create and maintain a logistics regulatory environment which is conducive to a sustainable fresh produce export industry.
- Prioritize port related logistics and functions required for continues fresh produce exports.
- Build and maintain strong and sustainable relationships with service providers and Authorities on operational level.
- Establish, monitor, and revise procedures and service standards to improve the fruit industry's logistics environment.
- Keep an accurate log of vessel movement across the port system.
- Develop an internal planning document, including current and future pack house, cold storage and port capacity to handle the growth in fresh produce export volumes
- Forecasting and estimating industry shipping volumes weekly and seasonally.
- Represent the FPEF in relevant industry committees and forums, including the FruitSA Logistics

**Requirements:**

- At least 3-5 years' experience as a Logistics Manager, preferably in the fresh produce export industry.
- Proficient in standard software
- Excellent analytical, problem solving and organisational skills.
- Ability to work independently and handle multiple projects

A degree or equivalent qualification in Logistics Management or Supply Chain Management. A qualification in Business Management / Administration will be an added advantage.
