Agbiz Grain has now completed the occupational qualifications for Grain Graders as well as Grain Handling Controllers (bulk grain handling/silo manager) and submitted such to the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO).

Following the development of the learning material, the process of implementation can now commence with an AgriSETA / QCTO TRAINING WORKSHOP that will be hosted by Agbiz Grain on Tuesday 6 March 2018. Since the Occupational Qualification process is new, this Agbiz Grain workshop is also relevant for all training providers accredited with AgriSETA to assist them with implementation, QCTO accreditation and roll-out.

Important implementation strategies also need to be determined. As you may already know, occupational qualifications replace the previous “legacy” qualifications. These qualifications have a strong emphasis on workplace and industry involvement, and thus Agbiz Grain has been proactive in developing the qualifications and empowering training providers to deliver training in this critical area.

WHO / WHAT MUST BE REGISTERED:

Independent trainers - Theory. Trainers must be registered

Training centres - Theory. Locations must be registered

Training centres - Practical. Agricultural businesses must make available silos as training facilities

In-house trainers / facilitators at centres - Practical. Site operations manager must be registered as facilitator / training manager at silo
