Ms Lisa Seftel was an anti-apartheid activist and worked for the Congress of South African Trade Unions until 1995 and then began working for the government once the country had gained democracy. She first worked for the Department of Labour and then transitioned into working for the provincial government.

Lisa Seftel worked as the Executive Director for Transport in the City of Johannesburg, a position she held for eleven years. In this position, she was responsible for the planning, leadership and management of transport-related issues including the rollout of the Rea Vaya Bus Rapid Transit System and public transport transformation.

Lisa Seftel is experienced in various government posts which further justifies her fit for Nedlac's head position. She has an Honours Degree in Industrial Sociology and a Diploma in Public and Development Management. She is currently studying for a Masters in Management and Wits School of Governance.

We would like to wish Lisa Seftel well in her new role as the new head of the Social Hub of South Africa. As the first female Executive Director of Nedlac, this brings a new era for Nedlac.
